Green Bay Departs Port Moresby after Supporting APEC Summit

PORT MORESBY, Papua New Guinea (NNS) -- The Navy and Marine Corps team aboard the amphibious transport dock ship USS Green Bay (LPD 20) departed Port Moresby Nov. 19 after supporting security efforts during the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) summit. Green Bay, with embarked Marine Light Attack Helicopter "Vengeance" Squadron (HMLA) 469, arrived in Port Moresby on Nov. 13 in support of APEC.

U.S. Sailors and Marines conducted various training evolutions both on and off the ship to demonstrate and practice mission capabilities along with Royal Australian Navy forces including landing helicopter dock ship HMAS Adelaide (L01), Royal New Zealand Navy forces, U.S. Coast Guard forces and multiple government entities from participating countries.

The HMAS Adelaide and Green Bay teamed up for cross deck flight operations. Two UH-1Y Huey helicopters, assigned to Marine Light Attack Helicopter "Vengeance" Squadron (HMLA) 469, and a MH-60R Sea Hawk and MRH-90 Taipan helicopter, assigned to HMAS Adelaide, conducted helicopter deck landing qualifications on each other's flight decks.

Green Bay is assigned to Commander Amphibious Squadron 11 forward deployed in Sasebo, Japan and is operating in the region to enhance interoperability with partners and serve as a ready-response force for any type of contingency. HMLS-469 is forward deployed to Okinawa, Japan.
