USS Patriot arrives in Jakarta, Indonesia

JAKARTA, Indonesia (NNS) -- The Avenger-class mine countermeasures ship **USS Patriot (MCM 7)** arrived in Jakarta, Indonesia, for a port visit, June 25.

Patriot is visiting Jakarta while operating in U.S. 7th Fleet to work with their Indonesian Navy (TNI-AL) counterparts to strengthen regional security and stability, and enhance interoperability.



This year marks 70 years of friendly diplomatic relations between the United States and Indonesia.

Patriot is part of Commander, Mine Countermeasures Squadron 7 and is forward deployed to Sasebo, Japan. They are operating in the U.S. 7th Fleet area of operations in support of regional peace and stability.

Webmaster's Note: **USS Patriot (MCM-7)**, an *Avenger*-class mine countermeasures ship of the United States Navy, and is the third Navy ship of that name. The hulls of the *Avenger*-class ships are constructed of wood with an external coat of fiberglass.



SASEBO, Japan – USS Patriot (MCM 7) has earned its seventh consecutive Battle “E” Award.

The criterion for the Battle Effectiveness Award is the overall readiness of the command to carry out its assigned wartime tasks, and is based on a year-long evaluation. The competition for the award is, and has always been, extremely keen. To win, a ship or unit must demonstrate the highest state of battle readiness.
